Luis Manuel C. Méjan is a Lawyer and a Law Professor. Since May, 2007, Mr. Méjan holds a Ph.D. degree in Law (Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México). After four years of free-lance Law practice, joined Banco Nacional de Mexico, the largest Banking Institution in the country, and worked there for 30 years, until he retired as Executive Vice President- Legal Counselor to the CEO and chairman of the Mexican Bankers Association's Legal Committee .
